V. Reports

- 1. Mission College: President Seher Awan
 - Mission College President Seher Awan reported that Mission College was represented at the Santa Clara Parade of Champions. Next, she stated that she hosted a principal's breakfast to connect with their K-12 partners. President Awan discussed how she plans to host a business breakfast to connect with community partners. She reported that Mission College was represented at the Hispanic Community Foundation Ball. President Awan mentioned that in collaboration with VTA and the local 265 union, they hosted the VTA apprenticeship graduation. She shared Mission College was awarded the Rising Scholars grant. Next, she reported that she launched her president's priorities web page. President Awan announced that the new director of marking and public relations will join Mission College in November. Lastly, she shared some upcoming events at Mission College such as the veteran's day event and women's basketball games.
- 2. West Valley College: President Stephanie Kashima
 - West Valley College President Stephanie Kashima reported that West Valley College hosted the grand opening of the Roots Food Pantry and affinity resource centers (African-American/Black Center, Pride Center, and Latinx Center). President Kashima stated she attended a teacher diversity pipeline summit. The college is expanding efforts to create a pipeline of diverse teachers. Next, she shared that West Valley College was recognized for excellent achievement for transfer rates of Latinx students. President Kashima reported that West Valley College was awarded a Mathematics Engineering Science Achievement (MESA)

grant. She noted some personnel changes at the college. Lastly, she reported that the college is continuing to work on increasing enrollment.

 - Messaging to donors in current market/economy. Finance Committee approved option for new endowment donors to opt for their endowment gift to be held in high-yield interest cash account w/ Lindbrook for a period of 12 months. It gives donors option for safekeeping of gift principal, while any interest earned is distributed as scholarship.

 Chancellor Davis reported that the board of trustees had a special board meeting to consider the financial analysis of the housing development for the colleges. Next, he stated that the board of trustees passed the budget to waive student parking fees, student health services fees, and provide free childcare.
